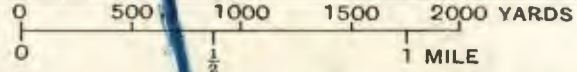

WEATHER INTERROGATION SUMMARY FOR MISSION OF 6 JULY 1944.

BASE AT TAKE OFF: (1652) 4/10 cumulus base 3500 ft tops 5-6000 ft. Nil middle cloud, 4/10 cirrus at 22,000 ft. Visibility 10 miles.

ROUTE OUT: 4-6/10 cumulus base 3500 ft tops 5-6000 ft breaking to 2-3/10 over Southern England and nil over Channel and Continent. 3-5/10 cirrus base 22,000 ft. becoming 5-7/10 over Channel and Continent base 27,000 ft. Occasional arvil tops of cumulonimbus over Southwestern England at cirrus level. line of altocumulus, west of Leicester running NW and SE base 13-14,000 ft tops 16 - 18,000 ft. Visibility unrestricted above haze layer.

TARGET: (2007) 5-7/10 cirrus at 27,000 ft. Nil low and middle cloud. Visibility unrestricted.

ROUTE BACK: 5-7/10 cirrus at 27,000 ft becoming 3-5/10 cirrus over England. Nil low or middle cloud. Visibility unrestricted above haze layer.

BASE ON RETURN: (2102) 3/10 cirrus. No low or middle cloud. Visibility 12 miles.

REMARKS: Dense persistent contrails by fighters at 30,000 ft. Wind; forecast good in direction and velocity. (20,000 ft 202 deg 38 knots.). Temperature forecast good (25,000 ft - 26 deg.). Top of haze layer at 4-5,000 ft.
